He worked in CERN/Geneva, Member of the UA1 Group under Carlo Rubbia (Nobelprice 1984, 1979 -1984. He is Founder and owner of the Engineering Consultancy "UHL Data" for Systems, from 1984 – 1991. From 1985 – 1998, he taught at the Polytechnic of Aachen, Dpt. Jülich for "Numerical methods in environmental and energy planning" and "Solar Architecture for Engineers"; then from 1991 – 2000, he was head of the Systems Analysis Group At Wuppertal Institute for Climate, Environment and Energy, he was the Research Director. He joint Eurosolar in 1987, and achieved many titles: 1987 - 1992 Member of

the Board of the German Section, 1992 - 1994 Vice president of the German Section, 1994 - 2000 President of the German Section and Member of the European Board, 2000 - 2006 Vice president of the European Board, since 2007 Member of the Scientific Board; 1996 Prize-winner of the competition „best environmental book of the year“from German Foundation for Environment, "Zukunftsenergien – Strategien einer neuen Energiepolitik", together with T. Reetz; 1996 - 2000 Member of the European Board of the "European Business Council for a Sustainable Energy Future - E5"; since 1997 Member of the Consultative Committee "100 Solar Districts" of the Building Ministry and the Ministry of Regional Planning of North-Rhine Westfalia; since 1998 Member of the „Factor 10/X Club“ for resource productivity and sustainable use of natural resources, since 2005 President; since 2001 Member of the "World Council for Renewable Energies"; He headed several institutions and taught in Leipzig, Aachen and Hamburg.
