

## Herman Darnel Ibrahim



Herman is a Member of National Energy Council of the Republic of Indonesia for the period of 2009-2014. It is a permanent and nationwide body which is chaired by the President of Indonesia. He represents the Renewable Energy Industry Stakeholder in the Council. He also serves as the Chairman of Indonesian National Committee of CIGRE, as the Board Member of International Geothermal Association [IGA], as the Chairman of IGA Western Pacific Regional Branch, as the Vice Chairman of Expert Board of Indonesian Renewable Energy Society, and as the Advisory Board of Indonesian Power Society. Herman was the President of Indonesian Geothermal Association 2001-2004, and OC Chairman of World Geothermal Congress 2010, Bali, Indonesia.

Herman got his First Degree in Electrical Engineering from Bandung Institute of Technology [ITB, Indonesia], M.Sc. Degree on Electrical Power System Analyses from the University of Manchester Institute of Science and Technology [UMIST], and PhD Degree on Energy and Environmental Policy for Power System Development from ITB Bandung.

Since 1979 to 2008 he worked with PLN the Indonesian National State Electricity Corporation. Among his important positions at PLN were: Director of Transmission and Distribution of PLN [2003-2008], Director of PT. Indonesia Power, a subsidiary of PLN [1999-2003]; President Director of PT. Cogindo DayaBersama, an energy services company [ESCO], a subsidiary of PT Indonesia Power [1998-1999].
