Her interdisciplinary thesis examines how projects can enhance local capacity to support solar photovoltaic technological systems in rural China. The research contributes to an AusAID-funded project on *overcoming barriers to renewable energy in rural Indonesia by community capacity building*. She has also conducted research on photovoltaics in remote communities in Australia, Nicaragua and Nepal. Ms. To has taught undergraduate and postgraduate courses on sustainable energy in developing countries and renewable energy policy, and worked as a sustainable energy policy consultant for the Australian

government. She has also worked with Oxfam and Engineers Without Borders on climate change and youth issues.
