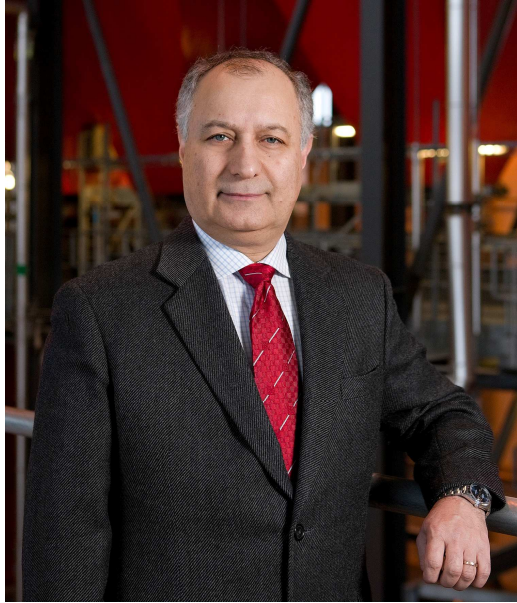


Prof Bahram Moshfegh



He studied at the Linköping University, Sweden, where he received a Ph.D. degree in Energy Systems in 1992. He was appointed Professor of energy systems there in 2000. Professor Moshfegh is the Chairman of Division of Energy Systems at the Linköping University since 2000. He has been involved as expert for Swedish parliament and funding research council both nationally and internationally, member of the scientific committee for the Swedish Research School Energy Systems, member of the scientific committee and organization committee as well as invited speaker for many *International Conferences*.
